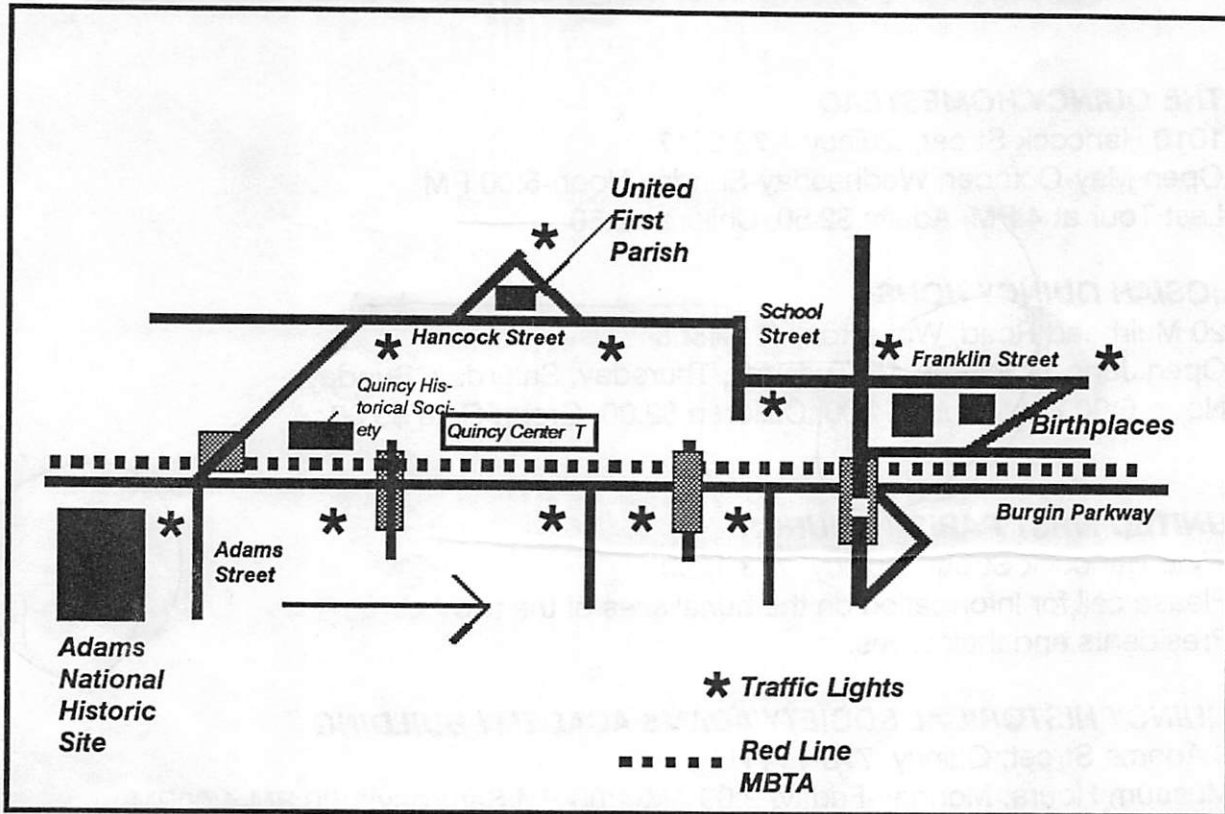

DIRECTIONS TO "OLD HOUSE" AND THE BIRTHPLACES



To the Birthplaces from "Old House"

At the intersection at Adams Street and Newport Avenue go Straight over bridge and railroad tracks. Bear right. Proceed through the Traffic lights to Hancock Street. Quincy Historical Society is on your right. Continue on Hancock Street. The United First Parish is on your left. Continue straight. (The road forks, bear right. Stay on Hancock Street). At the next traffic light turn right onto school street (Firestone Tire will be on one corner). Proceed straight through yellow blinking light. At next major intersection turn Left onto Franklin Street. The Birthplaces are 1/4 mile down on right (across from Quincy Savings Bank).

To the "Old House" from Birthplaces

Proceed down Franklin Street. (Follow Quincy Center Sign) Turn right onto School Street. At Traffic lights (Firestone Tire on Left), Turn left onto Hancock Street. Follow Hancock Street straight. At lights Hancock street divides, use caution. Follow Hancock Street around United First Parish. At Traffic Lights (Quincy Historical Society is on your left) bear left (Don't take a hard left, look for Brown Sign, After light, Buick Dealer will be on your left) At next traffic light, go straight, Adams National Historic Site will be immediately on your right after intersection.
