

recognize the historic value of the site and re-roofed the remaining camp buildings. During the 1980s, brush was cut down and burned in order to protect the camp from wildfire. In the late 1990s, the pump house and windmill tower was reconstructed, the southern stone building was restored, and the cold house was stabilized.

Hiking, exploring, and discovering the historic structures scattered across Camp Gap Ranch are popular activities.

From Burns, take Highway 20 west for approximately 40 miles to milepost 91 and turn left onto the Camp Gap Ranch entrance road.

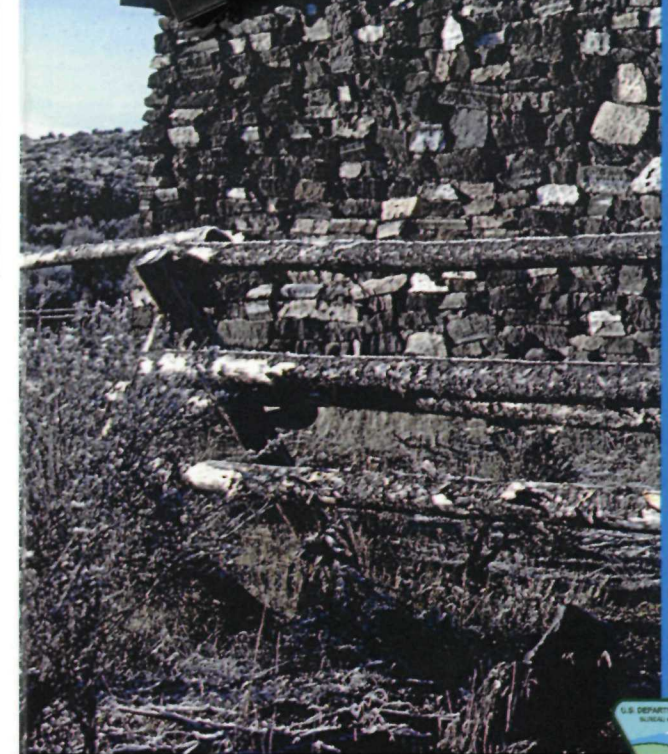
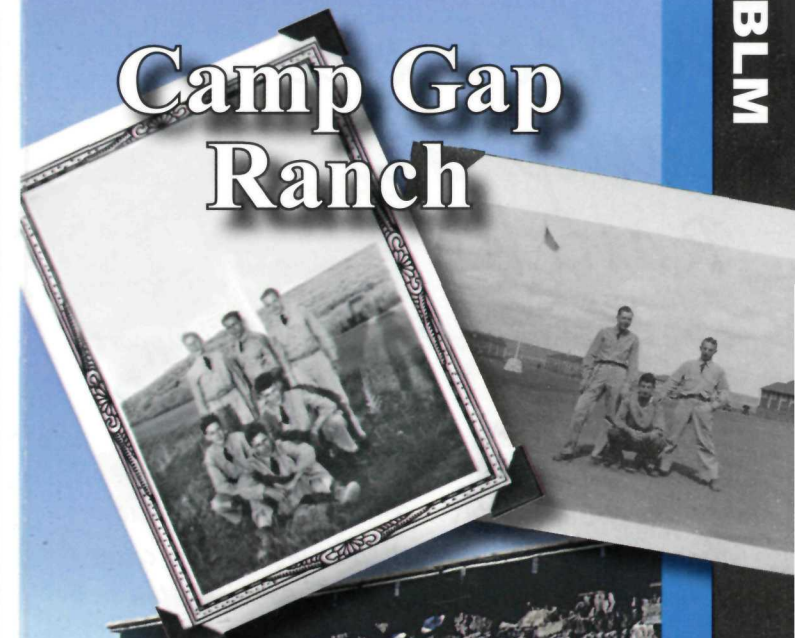
