

ANACAPA ISLAND

Picnic, swim or explore at this unique and unspoiled island. Public excursions run year round, leaving at 8:00 or 9:00 am and returning the same day at 4:00 or 5:00 pm, respectively, during fall, winter and spring, four days/week. On these trips we cruise the north and/or south side of the island to view points of interest including seals, sea lions, birds, etc. You will be ashore for 2-4 hours, weather and sea conditions permitting. From January to March, California gray whales migrate past Anacapa, therefore, more time is spent cruising the channel with the whales. The time spent ashore during whale season is about an hour.


The fgre* for a day trip is \$22.00/adult and \$11.00/child (12 and under). After making your reservations by phone, please send full payment within 7 days to confirm your reservations.

To make reservations, call us at the number below. Saturdays and Sundays fill quickly, so make your reservations at least two weeks in advance. Reservations cannot be made sooner than 30 days in advance, however. To run an excursion, we need 11 paid reservations. If we don't have enough reservations, we will cancel one day prior to trip date.

<u>Upon receipt</u> of your full payment, we will send you a receipt, a map, the time of departure, and an information sheet.

Camping - You may also camp on some of the islands. To camp, you must reserve a space for your return trip. After confirming your reservations, you must apply for a permit through the National Park Service. For camping permit applications, call (805) 644-8157 or write to Channel Islands National Park Headquarters, 1901 Spinnaker Dr., Ventura, CA 93001. During the summer a special camper run is offered on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Fridays, with a savings up to 50%.

Charters are available year-round. On all charters, a diver/naturalist is available to introduce you to the fascinating plants and animals of the sea. For school groups, a complete floating classroom trip is available.

ANACAPA ISLAND

Summer Schedule

East End Landing - All day excursion leaving at 8:00 am and 9:00 am, returning at 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm, respectively; going ashore for approximately three hours for picnicking and hiking along the nature trails, then cruising along the north shore of the island to view seals, sea lions and birds.

Fare: \$22.00 adult \$11.00 child under 12

Frenchy's Cove Landing - (Beach Day) Special landings usually on Saturday and Sunday for 3-4 hours for snorkeling, swimming and sunbathing. Cruise down the north shore to view seals and sea lions.


Fare: \$22.00 adult \$11.00 child under 11

1/2 Day Sightseeing Tours - Depart 9:30 am and 1:30 pm. A narrated cruise of the north shore to view seals, sea lions and birds. Look for pilot whales, blue sharks and porpoise on the channel crossing. Saturdays and Sundays.

Fare: \$11.00 adult \$5.00 child under 12

Comper Special Run - Depart mainland (Oxnard) 12:00 noon on either Friday, Sunday, or Tuesday, departing Anacapa 10:00 am on the same days. Round trip.

Fare: \$22.00 adult \$11.00 child

Cuvler's Horbor - Depart Ventura 12:30 a.m. Arrive San Miguel Island 7:00 a.m. Have breakfast before going ashore to explore Cuyler's Harbor and island interior on National Park Service Ranger led walk. Time for swimming or relaxing on white sandy beaches.

SANTA CRUZ ISLAND Summer Schedule

Pelican Bay - With the Nature Conservancy, once a month, departing at 8:00 am and returning at 6:00 pm. Cruise along the north shore of Santa Cruz Island, landing ashore for 3-4 hours. Moderately rugged trails, so guests should be in healthy condition. Naturalist leads walk into the interior to view the island's unique plant and animal life.

Fare: \$30.00 adult No child fare

Prisoner's Harbor - Departs Mondays and Fridays at 8:00 am. returning at 5:00 pm. Cruise along the north shore with a short landing at Prisoner's Harbor. Limit 12 guests. A truck tour of the interior. These trips are allowed through the permission of the Santa Cruz Island Co. and the Santa Cruz Island Club.

Fare: \$30,00 adult No child fare

SANTA BARBARA ISLAND

Santa Barbara Island Landing Cove. Departs Ventura 7:00 am, arriving Santa Barbara Island approximately 11:00 am for 4 hours of island exploration. View elephant seals, sea lions and island bird life. Snorkel and swim in beautiful kelp beds.
