*January 1, 2003 – March 31, 2003*

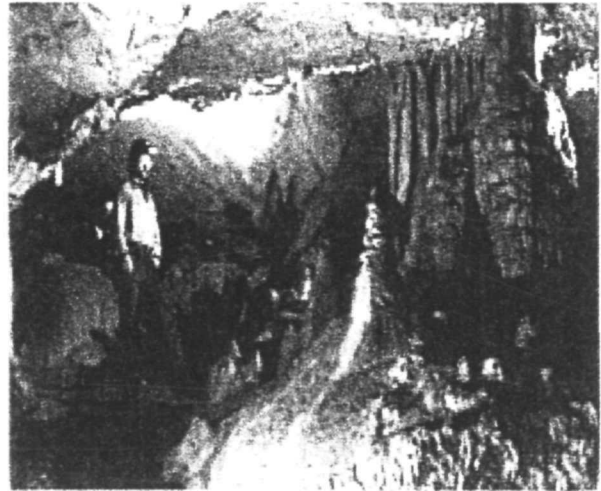
Saturday and Sunday 10 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Location: Tickets purchased at park visitor center

Join a park ranger in exploring Gap Cave, a majestic underground cathedral. With lanterns in hand, discover glistening stalagmites and sparkling stalactites and catch a glimpse of a bat or two. Listen carefully as the cave breathes;

perhaps you will hear whispers of Civil War soldiers who too explored the cave. We welcome you to join us on this exciting two-hour adventure. A mile of walking is involved and 183 steps must be negotiated within the cave. For the safety of all, small children in backpacks are not allowed.



**The purchase of cave tour tickets will be closed 15 minutes before the scheduled tour, as a 10-minute drive is required between the park visitor center and the tour departure point located at the Daniel Boone Parking area.**

Adults - \$7.00; seniors with Golden Age Passports - \$3.50; children twelve and under - \$3.50. Reservations are recommended and can be made up to one month in advance of the trip date.
