## WILDERNESS ROAD CAMPGROUND



#### **GENERAL**

The campground is open year round. 160 woodland sites welcome tent, trailer, and RV campers. 41 sites with 30 amp electrical hook-ups are available in loops B and C. Hot showers and potable water are located in the comfort stations. Campsites are on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### Camping fees:

\$10.00 per night per site. (Eight person maximum per site and four tents maximum per site.)
\$15.00 per night per site with electricity.
All sites one-half price for Golden Age/Access
Passport holders.

Group camping is located in loops G and O. 30 people or fewer- \$30.00 per night per site. More than 30 people - \$30.00 per night per site plus \$1.00 for each additional person in the group. 0-4 shelter is for day use only - \$20.00 per day. Groups must obtain reservations in advance.

Dump Station - See map on back.

Supplies are available in Cumberland Gap and Harrogate, Tennessee; Gibson Station, Virginia; and Middlesboro, Kentucky.

Hiking trails are nearby; ranger guided activities are conducted throughout the year.

### **CAMPGROUND ETIQUETTE**

- 1. Quiet hours must be observed from 10:00 P.M. until 6:00 A.M.
- 2. All wildlife is protected from hunting and harassment. Please do not disturb plants and animals.
- 3. Do not wash dishes in restroom sinks.
- 4. Bicycles are allowed only on designated bicycle trails and paved roads.
- 5. Firearms and fireworks are prohibited.
- 6. Cars and trailers must be parked at designated sites
- 7. Place all garbage in bear proof containers provided. Recycling containers are located throughout the park. Do not dump wastewater on the ground.
- 8. Digging and trenching for any purpose are prohibited.
- 9. All fires must be out before leaving.
- 10. All pets must be on a leash.
- 11. For your safety, roller-skating and skate boarding are not allowed.
- 12. Campers may stay up to 14 days.

Your campground fees are hard at work. We're improving the campground and trails, providing new visitor services and activities, protecting critical wildlife habitats, improving signs and exhibits, and providing for your safety and protection.
