Joseph M. McDade Recreational Trail is a planned recreational trail which, when completed, will extend for 37 miles on the Pennsylvania side of the park. The trail is open to hiking, biking, and crosscountry skiing. *Motorized vehicles are not permitted*.

STATUS AS OF SPRING 2008

Two sections are presently completed and open. *These sections do not interconnect.*

- — (I) a section along River Road PA from Hialeah Picnic Area PA to Turn Farm Trailhead PA. This section has a few steep short hills but mostly rises gently northward past fields and through forested sections. Water and restrooms in season at Hialeah Picnic area and Smithfield Beach. (5 miles)
- ——— (2) a section from Milford Beach PA to Pittman Orchard PA at Rt. 209. This section has a steep short hill at Milford Bridge but after that is mostly flat, passing fields and an old silo. Water and restrooms in season at Milford Beach. (2.7 miles)
