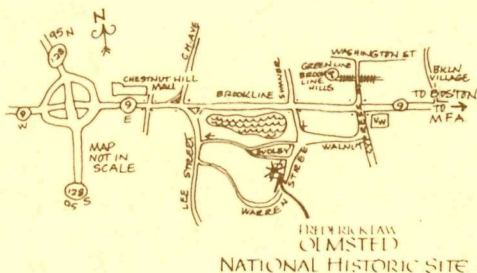

SITE INCLUDES LANDSCAPED GROUNDS & ORIGINAL BUILDINGS OCCUPIED BY OLMSTED, HIS SONS, PARTNERS & SUCCESSORS. A VALUABLE COLLECTION OF PLANS, PHOTOGRAPHS & OTHER DOCUMENTATION OF THE FIRM'S WORK IS CONTAINED IN THE SITE ARCHIVES.

DIRECTIONS

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

MBTA GREEN LINE (RIVERSIDE) TO BROOKLINE HILLS. RIGHT AT STATION 1/2 BLOCK TO CYPRESS ST. RIGHT ON CYPRESS & FOLLOW ACROSS RT 9/BOYLSTON ST. 2ND RIGHT TURN ONTO WALNUT ST & PROCEED TO INTERSECTION WITH WARREN ST LEFT ONTO WARREN ST & FOLLOW TO PARK ENTRANCE SIGN (15 MINUTES FROM STATION).

MBTA BUS # 60 (KENMORE-CHESTNUT HILL) TO INTERSECTION OF BOYLSTON & WARREN STS FOLLOW WARREN TO PARK ENTRANCE SIGN (5 MINUTES FROM BUS STOP).

AUTOMOBILE:

FROM BOSTON & EAST-FOLLOW RT 9 BOYLSTON ST WEST. AT 3RD STOPLIGHT PAST BROOKLINE VILLAGE, TURN LEFT ONTO WARREN ST PROCEED ON WARREN TO INTERSECTION WITH DUDLEY ST & VISITOR PARKING AREA.

FROM THE WEST-EXIT 55 OFF I-95/RT 128 (BROOKLINE). FOLLOW RT 9 EAST FOR APPROXIMATELY 5 MILES, PASSING THE CHESTNUT HILL MALL & THE BROOKLINE RESERVOIR. AT 1ST STOPLIGHT PAST RESERVOIR, TURN RIGHT ONTO WARREN ST PROCEED TO INTERSECTION OF DUDLEY ST & VISITOR PARKING AREA.
