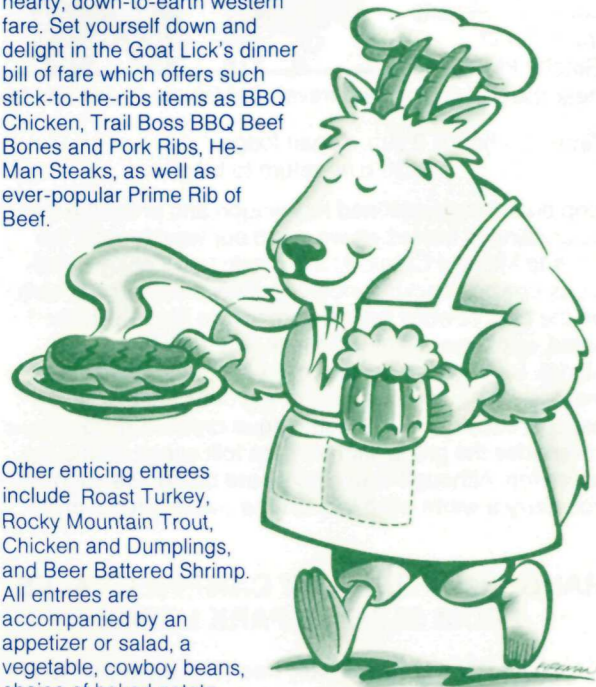


**New Restaurant At
GLACIER PARK LODGE**

**THE GOAT LICK STEAK
AND RIB HOUSE AT
GLACIER PARK LODGE**

Location: Main dining room, Glacier Park Lodge.
Hours: Breakfast 7-9; Lunch 12-2; Dinner 6-9.

This new restaurant features hearty, down-to-earth western fare. Set yourself down and delight in the Goat Lick's dinner bill of fare which offers such stick-to-the-ribs items as BBQ Chicken, Trail Boss BBQ Beef Bones and Pork Ribs, He-Man Steaks, as well as ever-popular Prime Rib of Beef.



Other enticing entrees include Roast Turkey, Rocky Mountain Trout, Chicken and Dumplings, and Beer Battered Shrimp. All entrees are accompanied by an appetizer or salad, a vegetable, cowboy beans, choice of baked potato, home-cut spiral fries or corn on the cob, a bread basket with authentic Indian fry bread and homemade muffins and biscuits. For lunch, select our famous Wrangler Stew or Western Omelets, Chili Burgers and Scrumptious Salads. To complete the meal, you may choose homemade cheesecake or hot apple cobbler a la mode.

Meals are served in the newly decorated dining room featuring the memorabilia of days gone by. Weathered wagon wheels, early western rifle and pistol displays and photos of Montana scenery add to the pleasurable dining experience. Youthful waiters and waitresses are garbed in denims, western shirts, and red and blue bandanas typical of the Old West.

The restaurant is named "The Goat Lick" after Mother Nature's wonder . . . a natural salt deposit located near the Middle Fork of Montana's Flathead River. Goats love and require mineral salts and will travel miles to reach the salt lick area. The feisty, rambunctious white Rocky Mountain goat is the symbolic "mascot" at Glacier National Park.

CIRCLE TOURS

Narrated full-day sightseeing tours are available from Glacier Park Lodge, Lake McDonald Lodge and Many Glacier Hotel. The tour takes passengers over Going-To-The-Sun Road with frequent stops for viewing, photography and a lunch stop. (Lunch is not included in fare.)

Boat Rental: Available at all cruise ticket offices except Rising Sun Motor Inn.

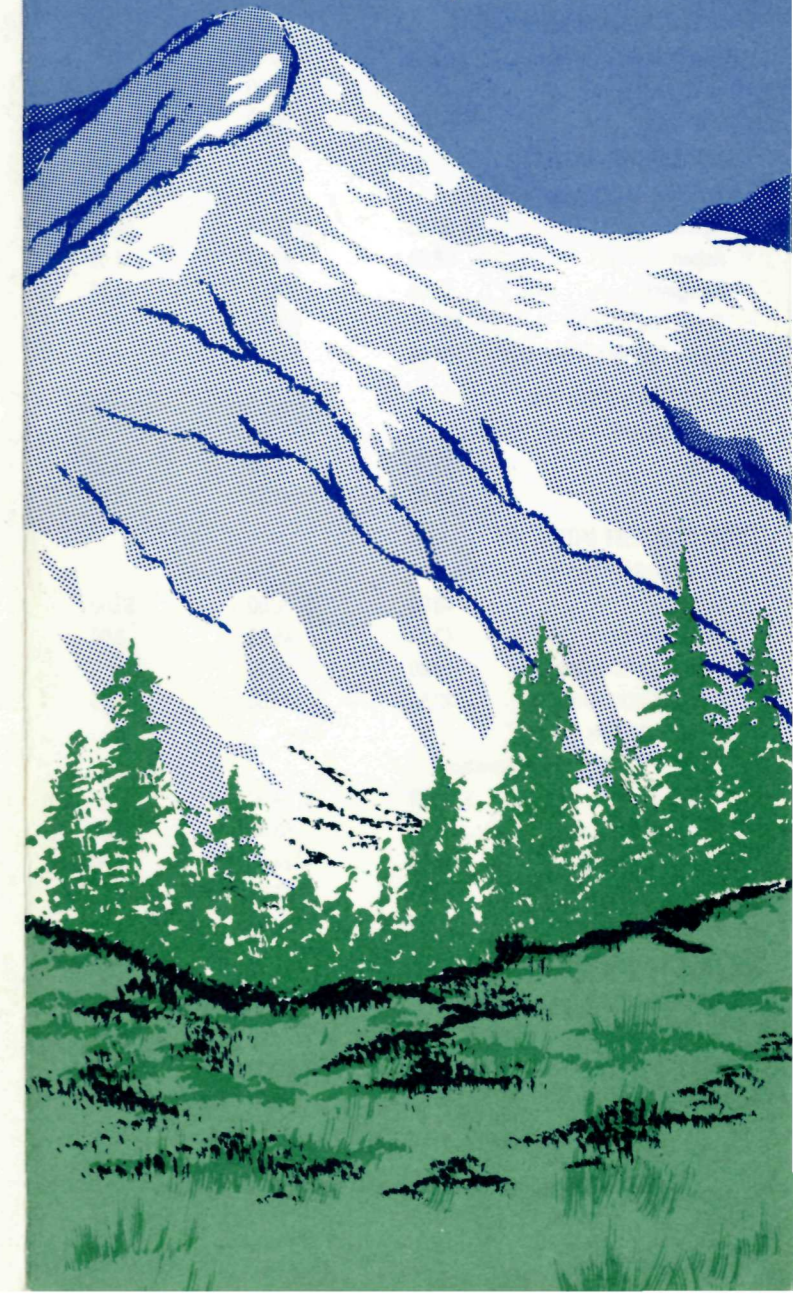

Hop on our old-fashioned hay wagon and enjoy the gentle ambling of horses as we wend our way through the trees to Midvale Creek. At the creek, you'll enjoy a delicious cowboy cookout including juicy steaks, fresh corn on the cob, cowboy beans, homemade biscuits, tossed salad, apple pie, coffee and milk (when children are along). Beer, wine and soft drinks are available for a nominal fee. The cookout is held in a grove of poplar and aspen trees next to the picturesque creek. A guitar player serenades the group with western folk songs during the entire trip. Although many nights are balmy, we suggest you carry a warm wrap in case the evening turns chilly.

RANGER/NATURALIST CAMPFIRE TALKS FROM GLACIER PARK LODGE

Coach fare, \$5.75; ranger talk, free (Tickets available at Information Desk)

Location: Departs from front of Glacier Park Lodge and travels to natural amphitheater in Two Medicine Campground.

Time: 2½ hours. 7:15 p.m.-depart lodge.
9:45 p.m.-return to lodge.

Here's the opportunity to experience an old-fashioned evening of story-tellin' around the campfire. Ranger/naturalists from the National Park Service talk on such subjects as Living History, Bears, Geology and Glaciation, Wildlife Ecology and Our National Park Heritage . . . all of which provide insight into the surrounding terrain, climate and abundant wildlife in the park. Guests are transported from Glacier Park Lodge via our historic red touring coaches (a scenic 30-minute trip each way). The campfire site is located near the shores of beautiful Two Medicine Lake. Beverages and refreshments may be purchased at the campstore close by. Most evenings are mild, but we suggest you carry a warm jacket.
