|-----------------|--|
| LIMIT | 1. Camping limit is 15 days. |
| HOUSE TRAILERS | 2. House trailers permitted in designated loops only. Other campers to use other loops. |
| OCCUPANCY | 3. To establish occupancy, leave something at campsite. |
| 48 HOUR ABSENCE | 4. Check with Campground Ranger if you intend to leave site unattended more than 48 hours. |

| CAMPING SITES | 5. Camp at designated sites only. <u>DO NOT MOVE ROCKS OR PARK OFF PAVEMENT.</u> |
| FIREWOOD | 6. Leave dead wood where it has fallen. Obtain firewood from woodpiles in each loop. |
| FIRES | 7. Build fires in fireplaces provided. Gas stoves may be used on tables or clear ground. <u>NEVER LEAVE A CAMPFIRE UNATTENDED.</u> |
| TRASH | 8. Burn combustible rubbish and place garbage in nearby containers. Keep a clean camp. |

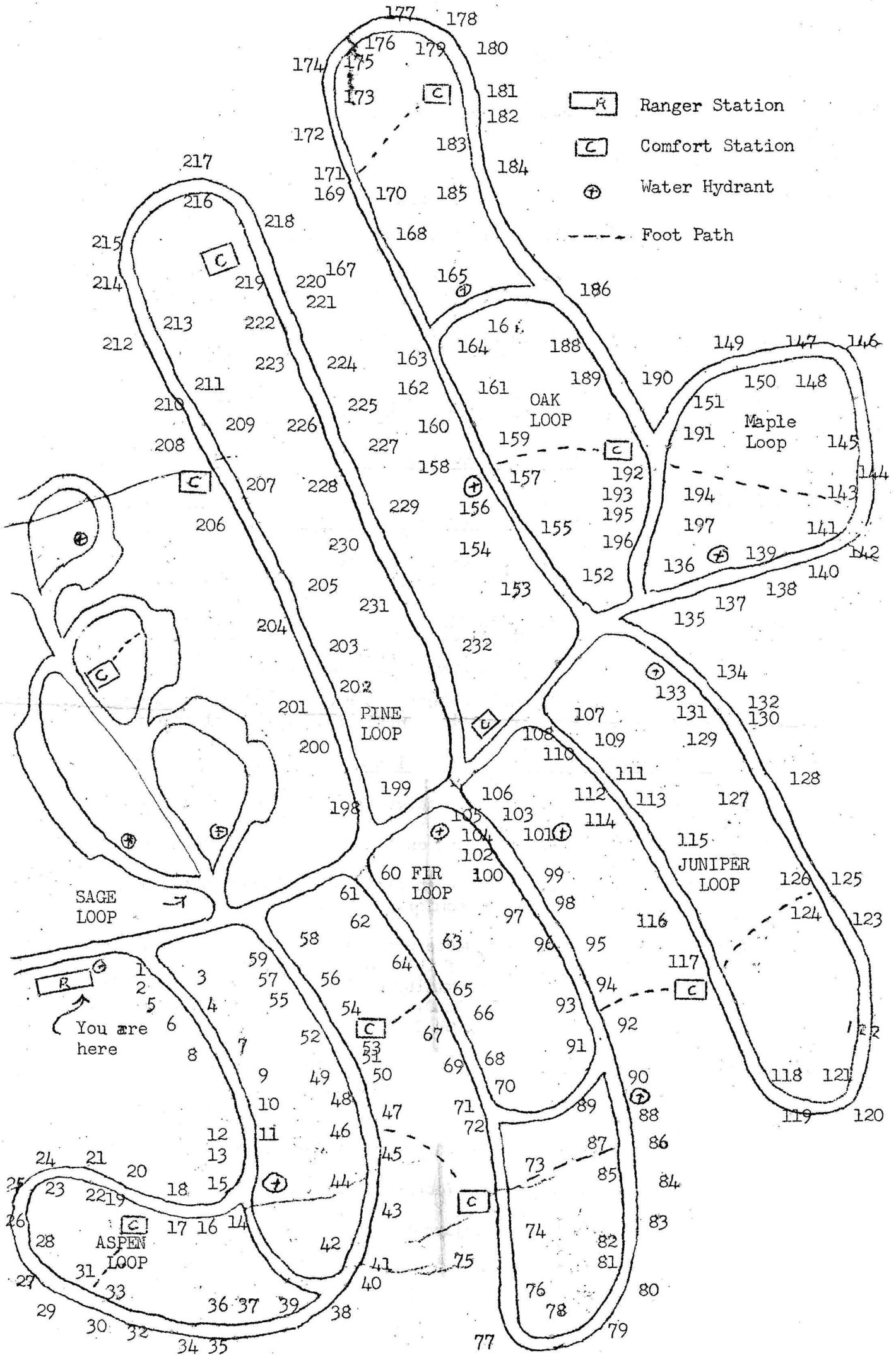

| QUIET HOURS | 9. Maintain quiet from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. |
| PETS | 10. Keep pets on leash or under physical restraint. |
| WASHING OF CLOTHES AND DISHES | 11. Do not wash clothes or dishes at hydrants or in comfort stations. |
| WASTE WATER | 12. Dump waste water in rest room toilets. Because of thin top soil, heavy campground use, and proximity of flies and rodents NO DISH ^W WATER OR OTHER WASTE WATER MAY BE DRAINED OR DUMPED ON GROUND. |
| WILD ANIMALS | 13. Do not feed, touch, tease, or molest any native bird, mammal, or reptile. |
