


Tusayan Route Shuttle Bus



The Tusayan Route (purple route), a part of Grand Canyon National Park's visitor transportation system on the South Rim, provides shuttle bus service between the gateway community of Tusayan, Arizona and the park.

Entrance Pass Required

Grand Canyon National Park's shuttle system is free; however, *visitors entering the park from Tusayan must present a valid park entrance pass*. Passes may be purchased at entrance stations or Tusayan businesses listed at right. Annual or lifetime passes, such as the America the Beautiful Federal Recreational Lands Pass, Senior, Active Military, or Access pass, are accepted.

Route Times and Stops

The Tusayan Route operates every day from May 11 through September 6. Buses run every 20 minutes between 8 am and 9:45 pm. Parking is available at IMAX/R.P.'s Stage Stop in Tusayan or Grand Canyon Visitor Center in the park.

- First bus leaves IMAX in Tusayan at 8 am; last bus leaves at 9:45 pm.
- First bus leaves Grand Canyon Visitor Center at 8:25 am; last bus leaves at 9:30 pm.

In-park Shuttle System

At Grand Canyon Visitor Center in the park, visitors can connect with the three additional shuttle bus routes, which serve many South Rim attractions, viewpoints, and visitor services. Mather Point and the Greenway and Rim trails are a short walk from this stop.

The Grand Canyon Visitor Center plaza features the ranger-staffed visitor center, a Grand Canyon Association Park Store, bicycle rentals and tours, a snackbar, and restrooms.
