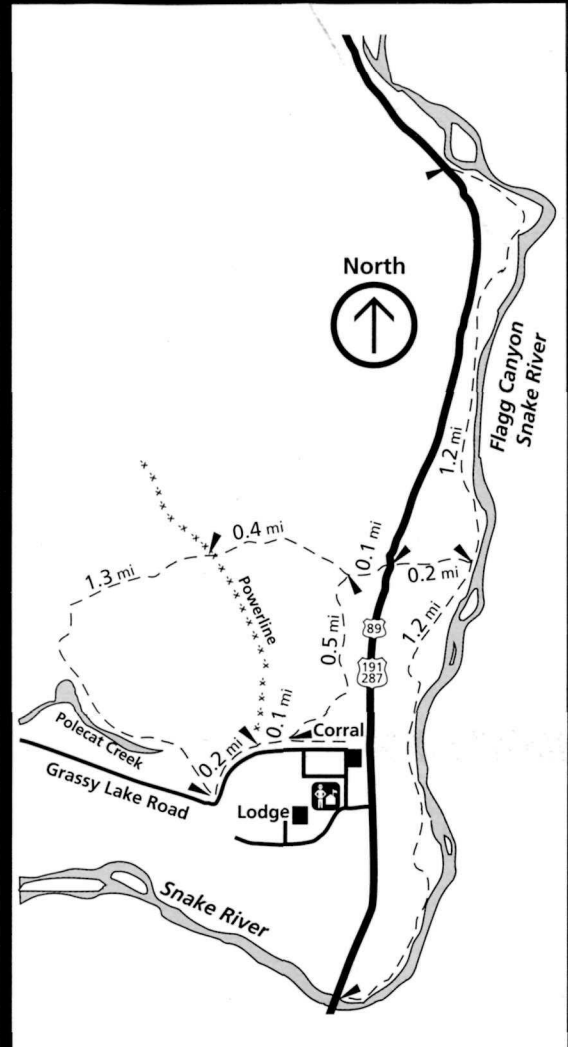

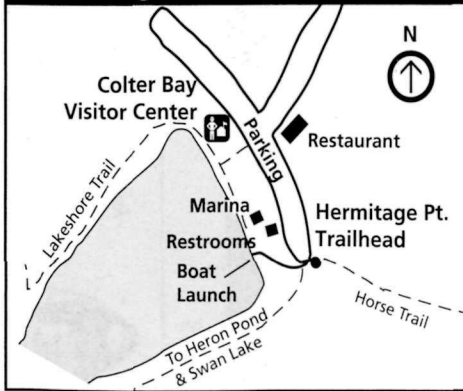
## Hermitage Point, Two Ocean & Emma Matilda Lakes Trails



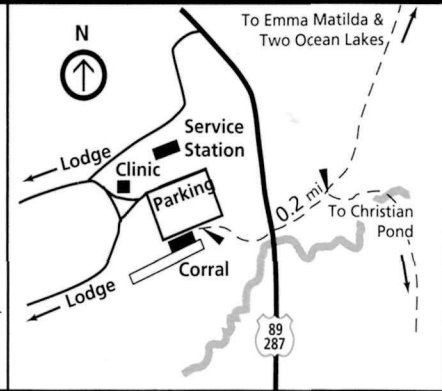

### Hiking Guidelines

- Pets, bicycles and vehicles are **NOT** allowed on trails or in the backcountry.
- Be bear aware! Make bears aware of your presence, avoid surprising them by making loud noises such as shouting or singing. Do not leave backpacks unattended.
- Respect wildlife: observe and photograph from a safe distance; 300 feet from large animals. Do not approach or feed animals.
- Hike on established trails to prevent erosion. Do not shortcut trails.
- Out of courtesy, step off the trail and remain quiet while horses pass.
- During July and August, trailhead parking areas fill early in the day. Start your hike early to avoid parking problems. Parking on natural vegetation results in permanent damage to plants and may start a fire. Please obey posted parking regulations. If you can, please carpool increasing your chance to find a parking space.
