## Special Amenity Tours



### Behind the Scenes Tour 10 a.m.

Have you ever wondered what's behind all those closed doors inside the Garfield home? Now's your chance to find out! See rooms like the servant quarters and the third floor, and peek into the windmill, horse barn, and carriage house. Learn about other original buildings on the site during the Garfield family's time. **This tour is the first Saturday of every month.**

### Behind the Ropes Tour 10 a.m.

Have you ever seen an object in the Garfield home that you wanted to see up close? Participants are able to go behind the ropes to get an up-close and personal look at selected pieces of the Garfield collection, and go inside the rooms of the Garfield home. **This tour is the second Saturday of every month.**



### **Please Note!!**

All Special Amenity Tours may include time spent outside, stair climbing, and standing for the duration of the tour and are **not recommended** for visitors who have difficulty standing, climbing stairs or walking for long distances.

Special Amenity Tours at James A. Garfield National Historic Site are a great way to learn **more** about the site and the Garfield family.

**Regular guided tours of the home are not included with the Special Amenity Tours, and are recommended to be taken at some point prior to any Special Amenity Tour.**

Regular guided tours can be taken during our normal operating hours.

Special Amenity Tours are \$15 per person (discounts apply to the Senior or Access Pass only; must have pass to receive discount). All participants must be at least 16 years of age. (Junior Behind the Scenes 9-15 years of age.)

### Garfield Neighborhood Walking Tour 10 a.m.

Experience a trip back in time to James A. Garfield's neighborhood through "then and now" pictures. This walking tour takes you 1.5 miles immediately east and west of our property on Mentor Avenue. Wear your walking shoes! **This tour is the third Saturday of every month (May – October).**

### Junior Behind the Scenes Tour 10 a.m.

We have created a special 90-minute Behind the Scenes program just for kids! Rangers will lead kids ages 9-15 in several activities at stations throughout the Garfield property. Kids are free; parents may wait in the Visitor Center to pick up kids after the tour. **This tour is the fourth Saturday of every month (May – October).**

### Architecture & Restoration Tour 10 a.m.

Twenty years ago the Garfield home was restored to its appearance in the late 1800s. Come and learn about the restoration and the architecture of this restored presidential site. This tour takes you all over the property, inside and out! **This tour is the fifth Saturday in June and August.**

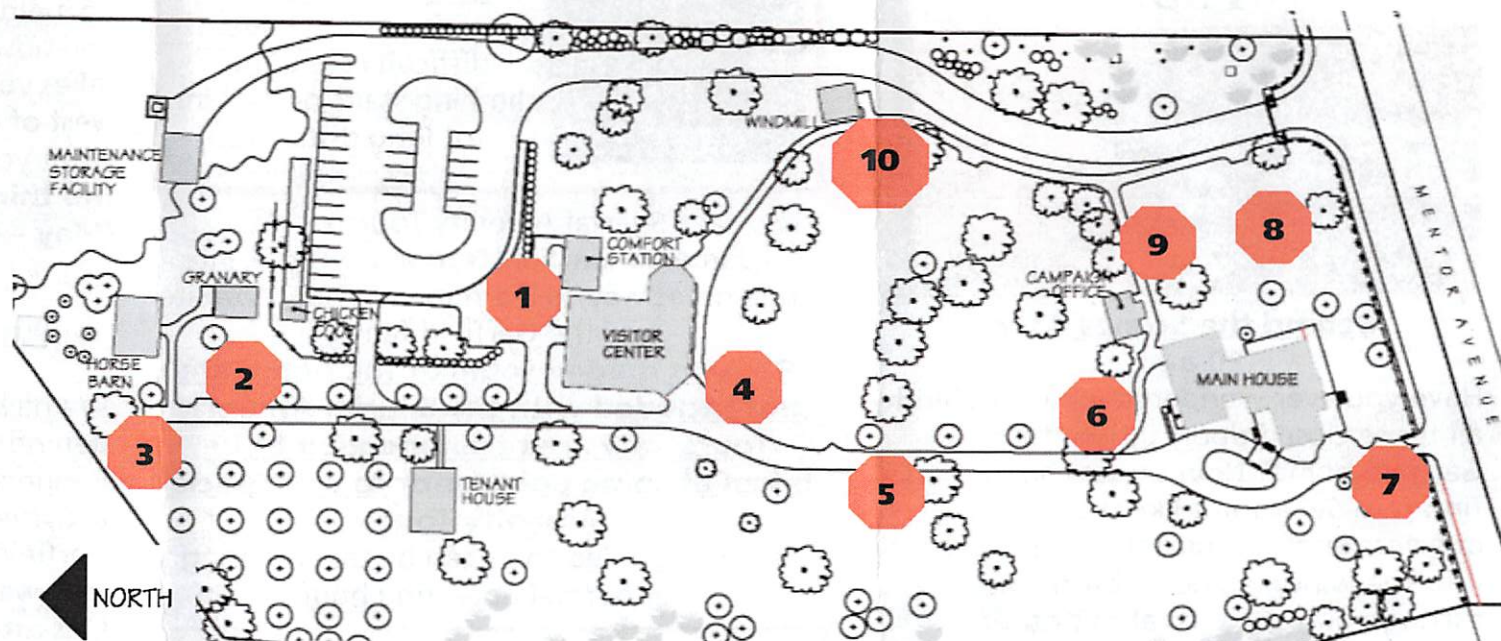


Look for signs around the grounds to enjoy our free, self-guided Cell Phone Tour.
