

Winter Wonderland

During the winter season, the resort offers snowmobile and guided snowcoach tours into Yellowstone, as well as cross-country skiing and snowshoeing.













The Flagg Ranch Resort

Bordering the Snake River, the western edge of Flagg Ranch was established as a United States Calvary outpost in 1872. Originally founded in 1910 as a guest ranch, the current resort is owned by a publicly held company and operated under the authority of the National Park Service. Ideally located between Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks, overlooking the Snake River, we are just 55 miles north of Jackson, Wyoming.

The resort offers a variety of outdoor activities including horseback riding, guided white water and scenic river rafting, hiking, and fishing.






Our lovely, mountain lodge houses an attractive dining room and native stone fireplace, The Burnt Bear Saloon, a gift shop, and grocery store, with an adjacent gasoline and diesel service station.

Situated among the pines, our comfortable log cabins have either two queen beds, or a king bed and sitting area. All rooms include a patio and rocking chairs.

Adjacent to the main lodge, a campground is provided with full RV hookups and pull through sites, as well as tent spaces. Services include shower facilities, twenty-four hour laundry, firepits and picnic tables.

Flagg Ranch Resort is ideally located two miles south of Yellowstone National Park and five miles north of Grand Teton National Park. AAA approved accommodations are available in our modern cabins dispersed throughout the property.
