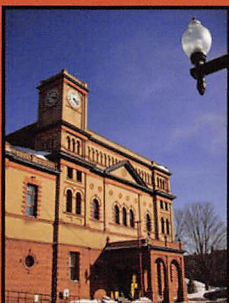
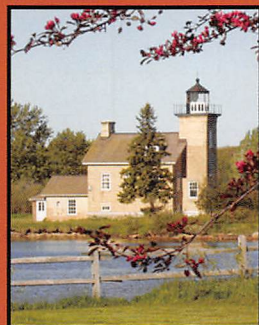
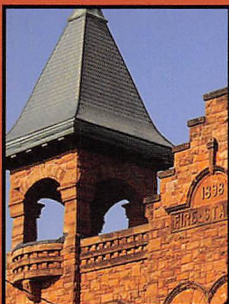


Discover the Copper Country

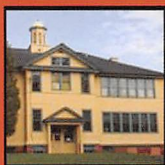
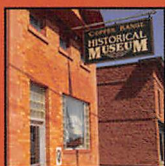
