Delta-01 Tours

Learn what it was like to have the awesome responsibility of thermonuclear war at your fingertips. The forty-five minute ranger-guided tour of the control center at Delta-01 begins with the grounds and topside support building. Visitors then descend via elevator 31 feet underground to the Launch Control Center to see the electronics used by missileers to control ten Minuteman II missiles.

Built for nuclear war, the control center features a small elevator and a tight underground space. To protect the historic facilities and to provide for visitor safety, each tour is limited to six participants. The tour is moderately strenuous and requires a quarter mile round trip walk. All tour participants must be able to walk and stand unassisted.

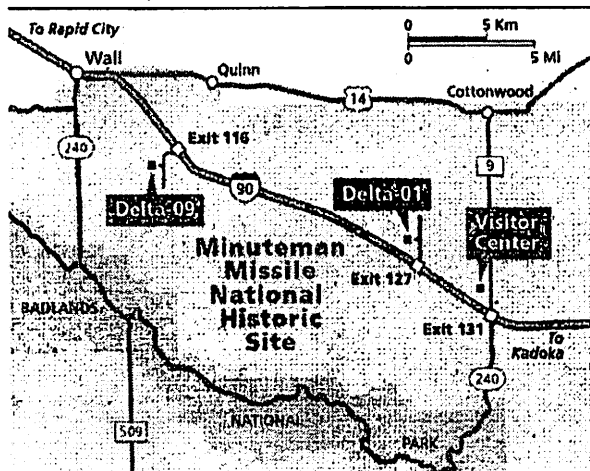
Tour Fee

Getting to Delta-01

Delta-01 is located 1/2 mile north of I-90, at exit 127. Visitor parking and restrooms are located just across the road from the historic compound.

Arrive at Delta-01 at least 15 minutes before your scheduled tour. All tours begin at the main entry gate to Delta-01.

Safety Requirements For All Tours

Visitors who wish to participate in the tour must meet the following criteria:

- Be physically capable of climbing two 15 foot ladders.
- Children must be at least six years of age, 40" tall, and able to climb the ladder unassisted. All youth must be accompanied by an adult.
- Be comfortable in a small elevator and other tight spaces.
- Be comfortable with heights of approximately 35 feet or about 3 stories. The elevator door is an open grate, not a solid door.
