Built by Thomas Lee in the 1730s, Stratford Hall is one of the great houses of American history. Four generations of the Lee family passed through its stately doors, including Richard Henry Lee and Francis Lightfoot Lee, the only two brothers to sign the Declaration of Independence, Revolutionary War hero "Light Horse Harry" Lee, and his son, Civil War General Robert E. Lee, who was born at Stratford in 1807.

Set on 1,900 acres on the Potomac River, Stratford Hall today offers a tranquil setting with hours of leisure activities for the whole family. Start by touring the

Visitor Center and its galleries. Take a tour of the Great House, walk the expansive grounds and view the beautiful gardens. Go for a hike on one of the many nature trails. Hunt for sharks teeth on the beach. Browse the many items in the gift shop. Stay overnight in one of our many comfortable accommodations. Come for a special event or for a summer camp.
