TWO WILDLIFE



The topography of Chincoteague Refuge consists of wide sandy beach backed by a series of low dunes which fall away to extensive salt marshes bordering Chincoteague Bay. Some parts of the refuge, particularly the southern end, also contain extensive areas of pine and oak interspersed with ponds and potholes. Several shallow freshwater impoundments were developed to make the refuge more attractive to waterfowl. Thousands of brant, geese, and ducks winter on the refuge. Shorebirds are an outstanding feature of the migration periods.

Large numbers of herons and egrets can usually be found on the impoundments from mid-spring to late fall.

Most birds are migratory therefore their seasonal occurrence is coded as follows:
