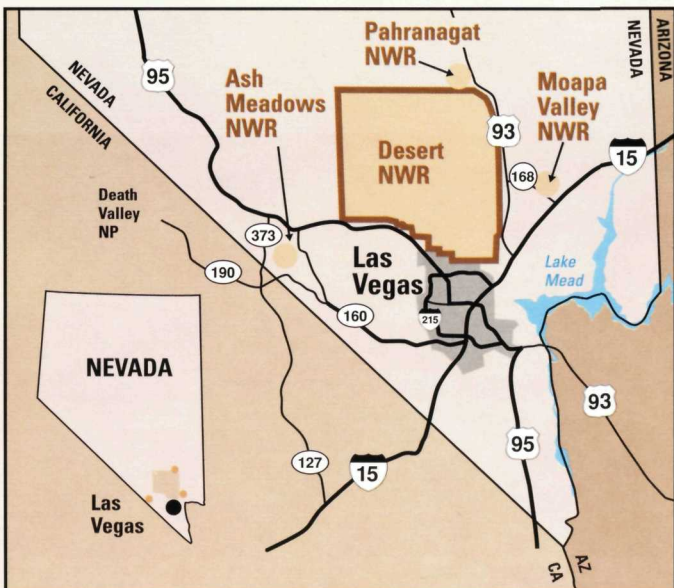
Encompassing six major mountain ranges and seven distinct life zones, Desert National Wildlife Refuge showcases the abundance and variety of nature that can be found just a short drive from Las Vegas.

Enter the refuge through Corn Creek. Considered one of the top birding locations in Southern Nevada, Corn Creek offers a new visitor center, picnic area, and five trails, three of which are ADA accessible.

With a high clearance vehicle, the expanse of the refuge awaits your exploration. From rugged backcountry roads, to campsites nestled amongst pine trees, to long hikes in solitude, there is a little of everything at Desert.
