Completed in 1941, Entiat National Fish Hatchery (ENFH) is one of three hatcheries built to mitigate the impact of Grand Coulee Dam on salmon and steelhead. ENFH currently raises and releases at least 400,000 summer Chinook salmon. The summer Chinook program began in 2009, and by 2018, the run was setting records. A robust recreational fishery is built on Entiat NFH summer Chinook.

A wetland drainage area created in 2011 is now rich in plant and wildlife diversity. A trout pond used for special events is surrounded by young trees. The riverside Red Willow Trail provides views and interpretation of riparian conservation projects.



From hatchery, follow Entiat River Rd. to US-97 Alt. West shore fishing via several access points along US-97 Alt. (Silicosaka Park; Will Risk Memorial Park).

Chelan River Chinook, sockeye, coho salmon, rainbow trout







From hatchery, follow Entiat River Rd. to US-97 Alt. Turn left, follow US-97 Alt. N for 19.3 miles. Turn left on W. Woodin Ave., follow 0.4 miles to Chelan Riverwalk Park.
