Litchfield Wetland Management District

The Litchfield Wetland Management District was established in 1978 to preserve and protect habitat for waterfowl and other wildlife. The district manages over 145 federally-owned Waterfowl Product Areas (WPAs) covering approximately 32,000 acres in southcentral Minnesota within the counties of Kandiyohi, McLeod, Meeker, Renville, Stearns, Todd and Wright. These areas contain a collection of ecologically important wetland and grassland habitats, including prairie, and provide food and shelter for 318 species of birds.

The following bird list was compiled from station records and the knowledge of visiting birdwatchers and local ornithologists. Seasonal abundance of each species is noted as follows:

SP - Spring (March - May)
S - Summer (June-August)
F - Fall (September - November)
W - Winter (December - February)

a - abundant; common species that is very numerous
c - common; likely seen or heard in suitable habitat
o - occasional; seen only few times during season
r - rare; seen only at infrequent intervals or years
