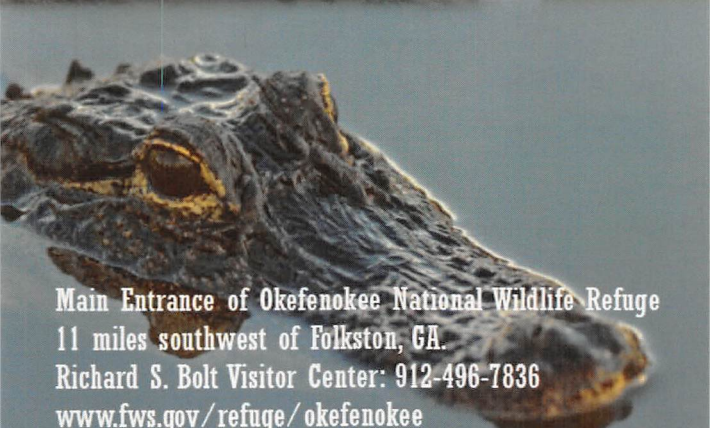

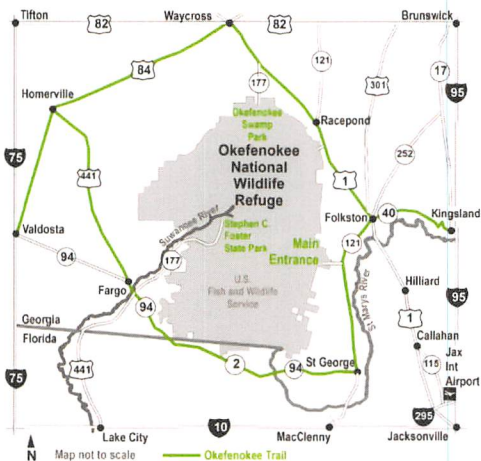


Main Entrance of Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge

Stephen C. Foster State Park
