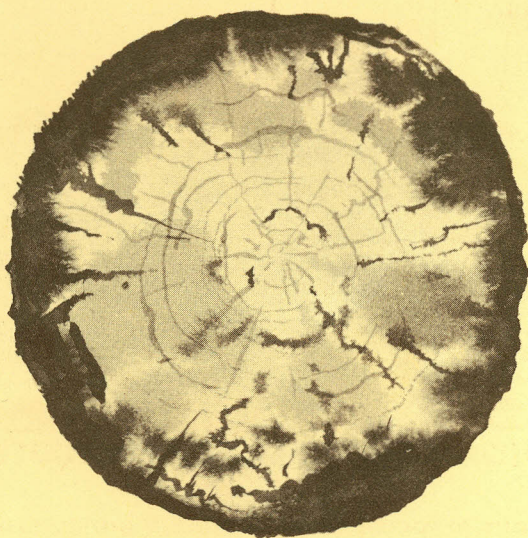

## LEAVE THE FRAGMENTS



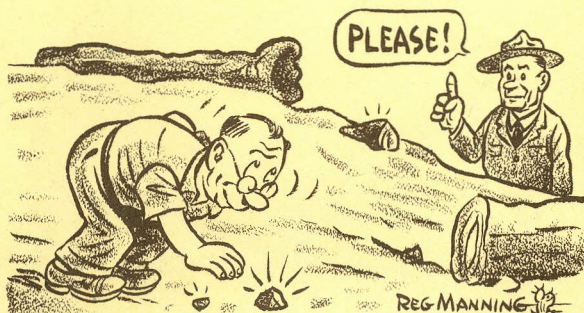
## WHERE NATURE LEFT THEM

# ATTENTION

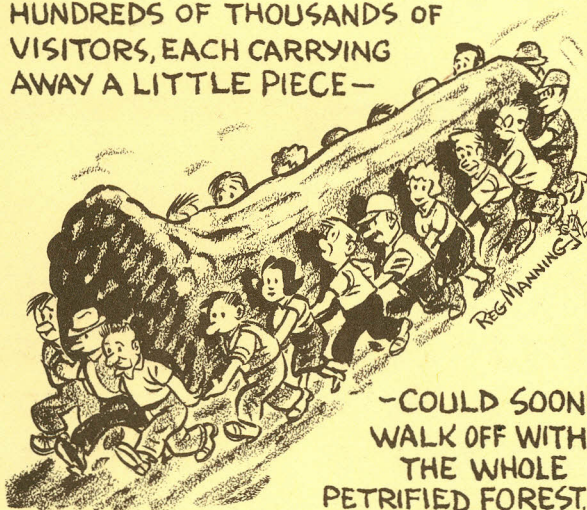
Help protect your National Park. Do not remove petrified wood or other natural objects such as flowers, rocks, and Indian relics.

Your cooperation will make it unnecessary to impose the penalties provided under Federal laws for protection of Petrified Forest National Park.
