

About your Pass



In 2007, the Golden Age, Golden Eagle, and Golden Access Passes were replaced with a new series of inter-agency passes called the "America the Beautiful - National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass."

The passes are valid at more than 2,000 federal recreation sites. Most national parks are free to enter. Of the **423 total** NPS sites, **fewer than 118** charge for entry. The passes also cover entry fees at many Bureau of Land Management, Army Corps of Engineers, and other federal recreation lands.

Concessionaires

Concessionaires charge for their services as any private company does. Their contract with the individual agency dictates if the concessionaire has to accept the Interagency Passes. Concessionaires might operate parking lots, campgrounds, boat ramps, lodging and more on behalf of the agencies.

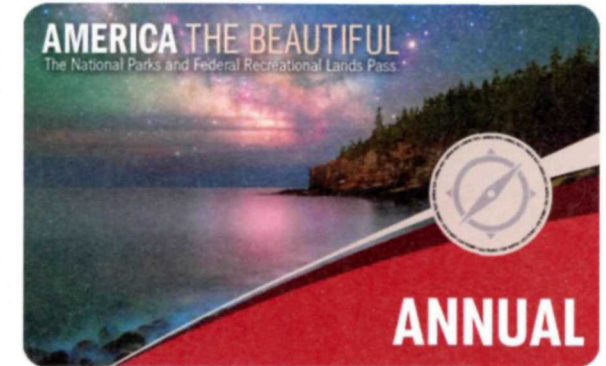
About Waco Mammoth National Monument

Waco Mammoth is a partnership park, operated jointly by the National Park Service, the City of Waco, Baylor University, and the Waco Mammoth Foundation. The site opened as a city park in December 2009 and became a national monument in July 2015.

Please note: America the Beautiful passes do not apply to tour fees. Please support our preservation mission as access to the *in situ* fossil bed is by tour only while this new unit of the NPS is developed.

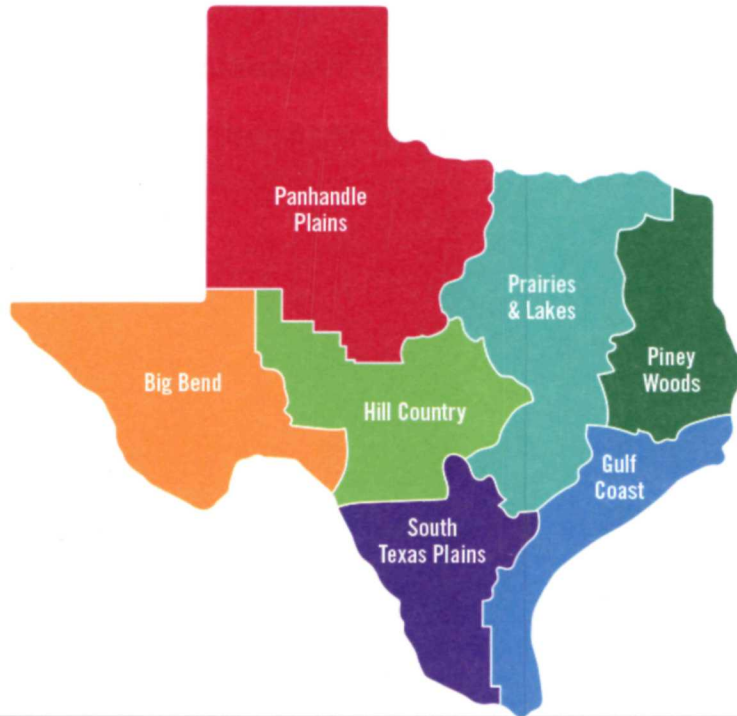


Where to Get an NPS Pass in Texas
