- **Use a flashlight if entering the cave. Special hazards exist - watch your head!**
- **Shortcutting on trails causes erosion and injuries.**
- **Climbing at the Pinnacles is only for trained people with the proper equipment.**



- Carry water if hiking during warm weather.
- Wear proper foot-gear if entering the backcountry.
- Feeding park wildlife make them easy prey for predators. These animals will bite and often transmit diseases.
- The speed limit in the monument is 25 mph.
