The eruption of Sunset Crater Volcano started less than 1,000 years ago and profoundly affected this land and its people.

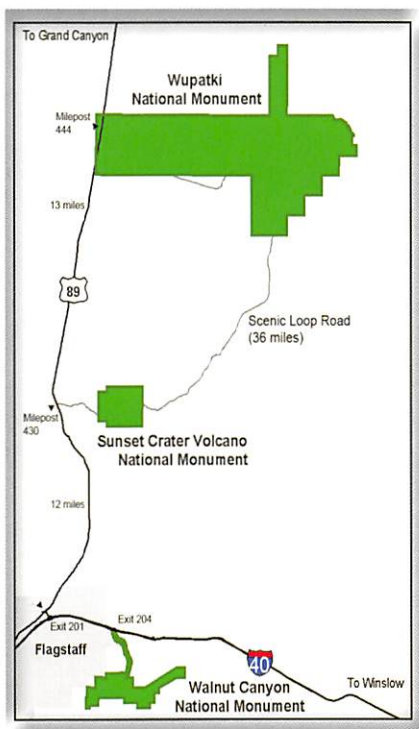


Wupatki
