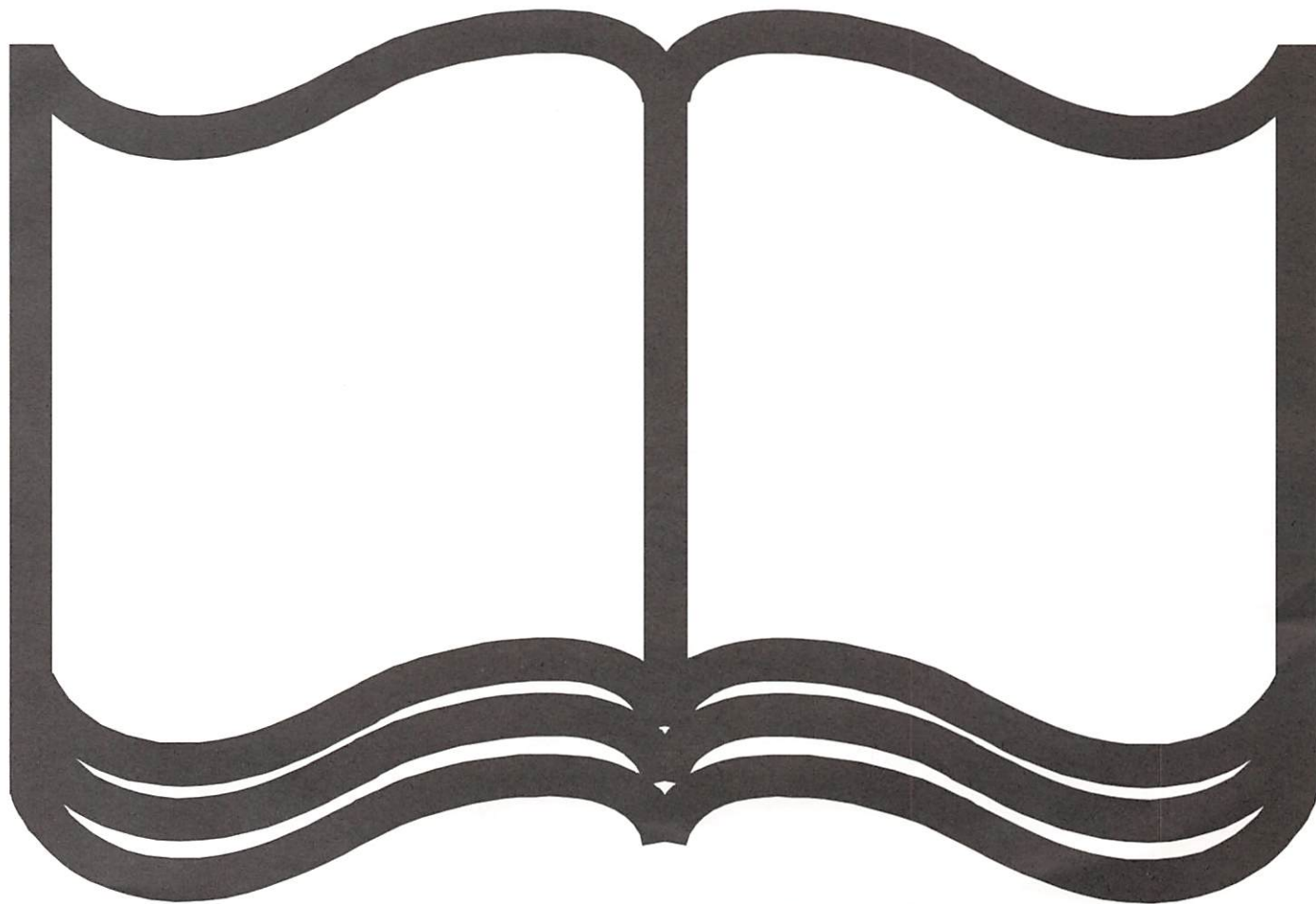

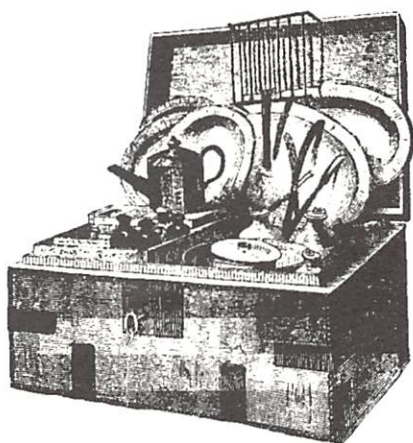

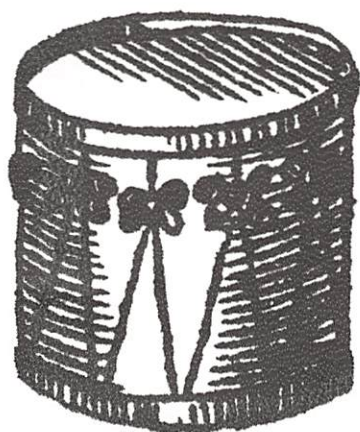

"...the great tacticians of the campaign were the hills and forests, which a young Polish engineer was skillful enough to select for my encampment."










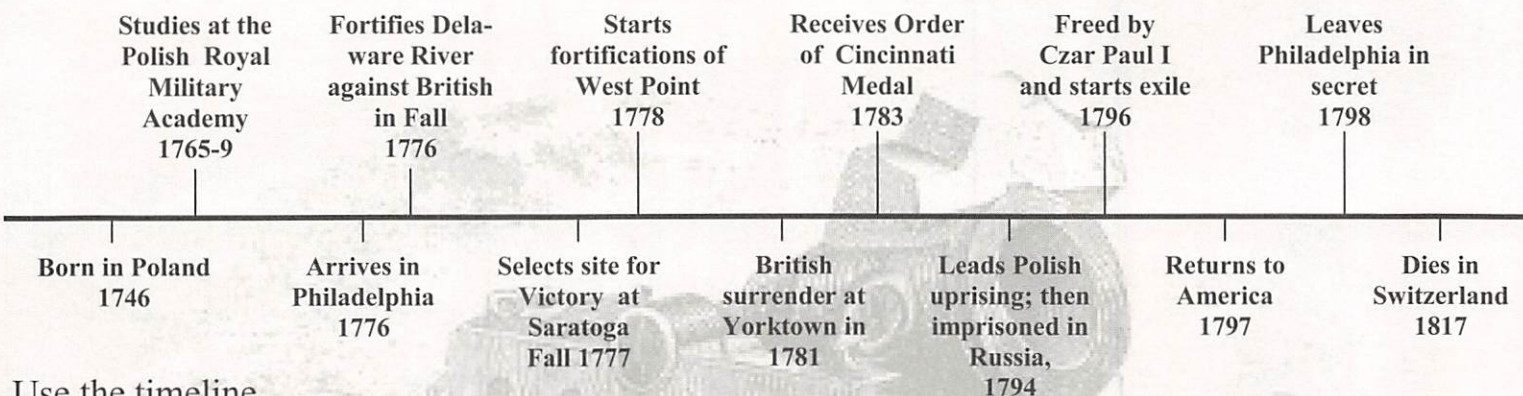
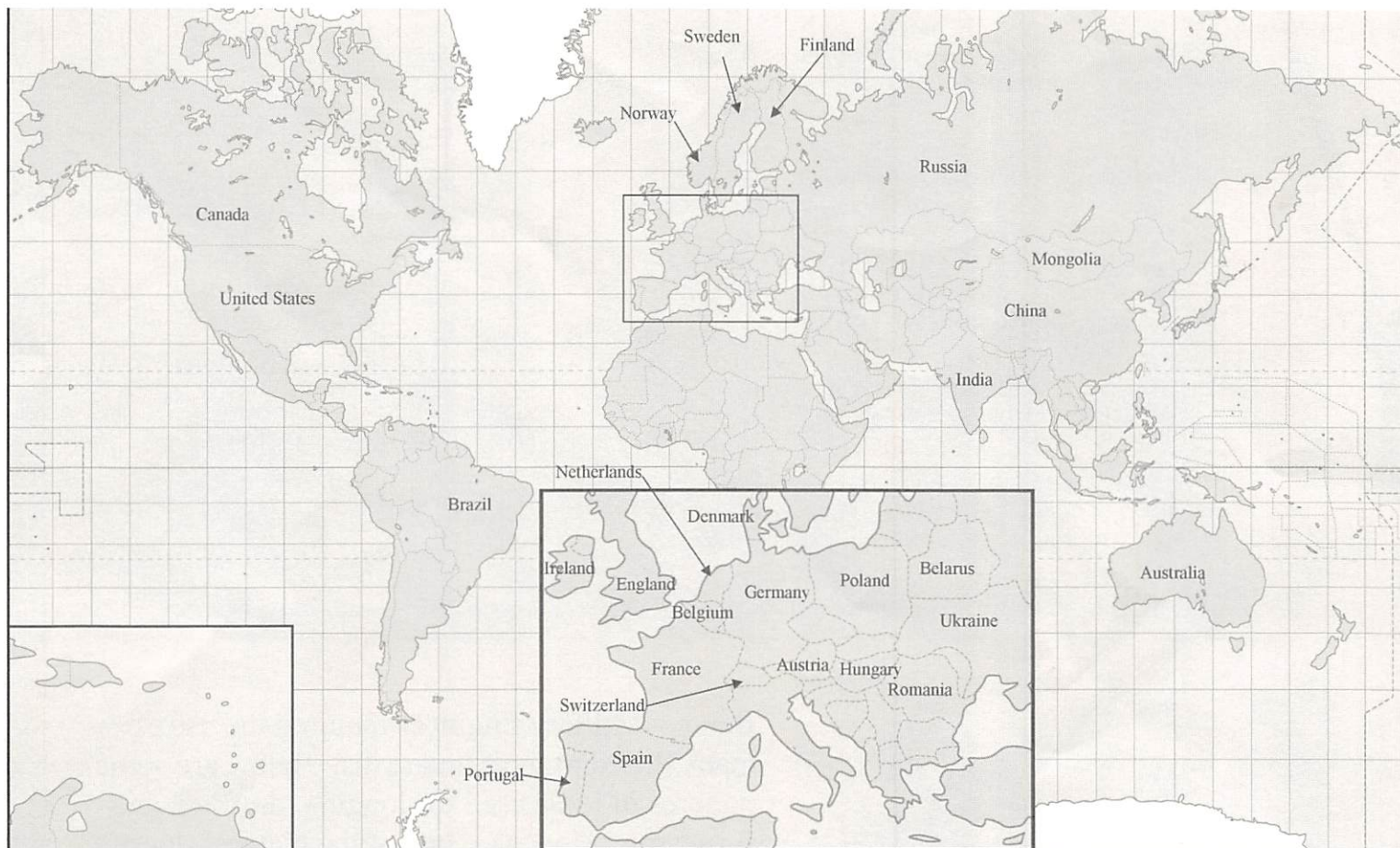
