Born: August 16, 1847

Died: August 3, 1915

Johnny Cook, a bugler with Battery B, 4th U.S. Artillery, became one of the Civil War's youngest Medal of Honor recipients for his conduct during the battle of Antietam.

His citation reads: "Volunteered at the age of 15 years to act as a cannoneer, and as such volunteer served a gun under a terrific fire of the enemy."
