Fact: The Mummas were left with only a pocket watch after their home was destroyed by the battle.

Samuel and Elizabeth Mumma and their 13 children lived near the Dunker Church and left their home two days before the battle of Antietam. Upon returning, they found their property had been burned by Confederate soldiers to prevent Union sharpshooters from occupying the house. The next year, they rebuilt their home with help from their community.
