



Ferry Hill Place

Sharpsburg, Maryland

Built: 1812-1920

Home to Henry Kyd Douglas, “youngest member of [General Stonewall] Jackson’s staff,” Ferry Hill Place overlooked Boteler’s Ferry on the Potomac River and C&O Canal in Sharpsburg, Maryland. Slaves, free blacks, and whites worked the plantation before the Civil War. During the war Ferry Hill was often occupied by troops from both North and South.
