# Try it!



Look for beavers and their lodges, dams, or chewed trees. Muskrats are smaller with a thin, not wide, tail.



Pretend to be a beaver family. “Chew” sticks, swim, fix your dam, and sleep in your lodge.



Count how long it takes to “swim” to home base after one “beaver” slaps its tail (claps) to signal danger.
