



COYOTE

Wildlife may not know better—but YOU do! Give them room: Stay away 25 yards!

Coyotes are one of Earth's most adaptable animals. Both predators and scavengers, they will eat almost anything. They can jump up to 13 horizontal feet (4 m) and clear a five-foot (1.5-m) fence without touching it. Coyotes range from grayish-brown to reddish-brown, usually with a white belly. Coyotes growl and bark like other canines but are best known for their yips and howls, which identify territories and help pairs or family groups find each other.

When closely approached or fed, coyotes may become aggressive. This is dangerous for people and coyotes and can cause the coyote to be lethally removed from the population.
