Bark Ranger Gracie is a border collie with an unusual job: she helps keep wildlife and humans a safe distance apart. Gracie was trained to be a wildlife shepherding dog at the Wind River Bear Institute. Her owner/handler is a park biologist who also received special training. At Logan Pass, Gracie and Ranger Mark move bighorn sheep and mountain goats out of the congested parking lot by applying pressure from a distance.
