United States Armory & Arsenal at Harpers Ferry Authorized: 1794

Opened: 1802
George Washington selected Harpers
Ferry as the site of a national armory.
American soldiers used muskets and
rifles produced here in the War of
1812, the Mexican War, and the
Civil War. The factory buildings were
destroyed in June, 1861, as the Civil
War positioned the armory on the
border between North and South.
