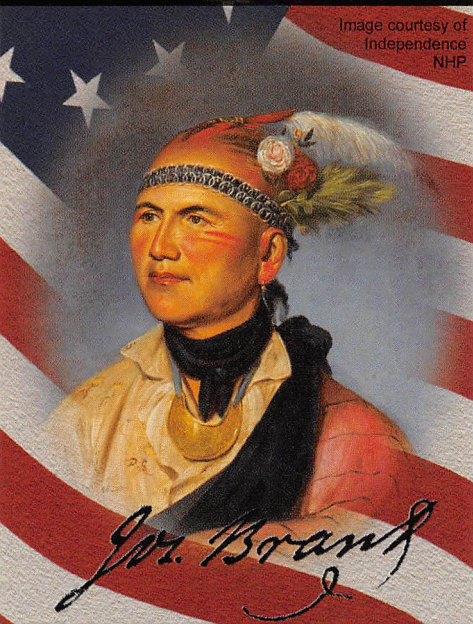

Joseph Brant

b. Cuyahoga, c. 1743. d. Ontario, 11-24-1807.

Known as Thayendanegea to his fellow Mohawks, Brant saw western expansion as a threat to the Mohawk people. He met with British King George III and fought against the Americans during the Revolution. After the war, Brant visited President Washington in Philadelphia. He later led his people to Canada.
