Naturalist William Bartram explored the southeastern part of North America. He took notes about plants and animals, and published a book, *Travels Through North and South Carolina, Georgia, East & West Florida*. This book provided the first complete list of known North American birds. It also tells of the respect that Bartram and the Native Americans had for each other. Seminole Chief Ahaya the Cowkeeper called Bartram "Puc Puggy" - the Flower Hunter.
