Born: March 23, 1834

Died: January, 1905

Stephen Longfellow, nephew of the famous poet Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, served in the 20th Massachusetts Infantry during the Civil War. This unit, also known as the "Harvard Regiment," had some of the highest losses of any Union regiment during the Civil War. Stephen was wounded at Fredericksburg, Gettysburg, and Spotsylvania.
