In 1862, the 14th New Jersey Infantry regiment established a camp near Monocacy Junction to protect the B&O Railroad. They returned during the 1863 Gettysburg Campaign to protect bridges and other strategic targets, and again to fight fiercely on July 9, 1864 during the battle of Monocacy. They became known as “the Monocacy Regiment.”
