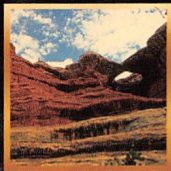

CANYONLANDS NATIONAL PARK

MOAB, UTAH

The surreal beauty of Canyonlands National Park comes from the marvelous mingling of canyons, mesas, buttes, spires, arches and fins that decorate the arid landscape. The rich earth tones set in stunning contrast to the blue Utah sky.

By car, the Shafer Canyon, Green River, and Grand View Point are must-see overlooks all within The Island in the Sky District. Upheaval Dome, Mesa Arch, Angel Arch, the White Rim and the Confluence Overlook can be viewed only by foot trails or high-clearance four-wheel-drive roads.

Recreational activities include mountain biking, backpacking, rafting and hiking.
