
DEVILS TOWER





Proclaimed America's first national monument, Devils Tower rises 867 feet above Ponderosa Pine forests and prairie grasslands. Volcanic venting and erosional processes exposed harder igneous rock which cooled and cracked forming massive vertical columns.

Abundant opportunities for wildlife viewing, photography and hiking offer visitors a variety of recreational activities. Technical rock climbing is allowed in the monument

through a permit system.

More than a recrational area, Devils Tower is sacred to many: American Indians. Traditional cermonies continue to renew the rich cultural heritage of Devils Tower National Monument.
