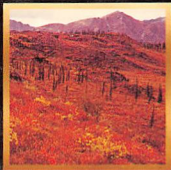

No roads. No trails. No shelter. No supply facilities. Certainly the Gates of the Arctic National Park and Preserve is not for everyone. But for those with proper outdoor survival skills - and an adventuresome spirit - this remote region of the Arctic offers a true wilderness experience.

The "Gates", Frigid Crags and Boreal Mountain, herald the entrance to this blustery arctic region where the seasons are nothing short of dramatic.

Though vegetation is quite limited due to the harsh environment, visitors will find that animals do exist here. Caribou, Dall sheep, wolves, moose, grizzly and black bears are among the park's native wildlife.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Allow for delays in travel or emergencies by bringing adequate reserves of food and supplies. Be prepared for mosquitoes and snowy or stormy weather throughout the summer.
