GREAT BASIN NATIONAL PARK

BAKER, NEVADA

Alpine tundra, mountain meadows, wildflowers, glistening streams and lakes are among the many wonders of Great Basin National Park. The park represents a hydrologic region where water, precious to the West, has no access to the ocean. The rain and river waters drain into aquifers or evaporate with the desert heat.

The South Snake Range is the major feature of Great Basin National Park. More than a dozen of the park's peaks top 10,000 feet.

Of special interest in the park are the bristlecone pine trees which are some of the world's oldest living things.
