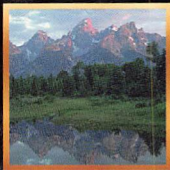

# GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK

The spectacular Teton Range, reflected in the smooth lake waters of early morning, attracts millions of visitors each year to Grand Teton National Park. The absence of foothills lend an air of drama to the jagged, steep-sided mountains which seem to burst out of the valley in bold fashion.

Indeed the lakes are popular for fishing, boating and just admiring; Jenny Lake and Jackson Lake being two of the favorites.

Wildflower lovers will delight in the glorious displays of buttercups, scarlet gilia, lupine, yellowbells and forget-me-nots.

## SPECIAL INFORMATION
