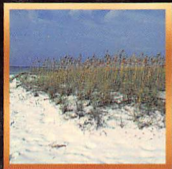

From Mississippi's West Ship Island to Florida's Santa Rosa Island, parts of the 150 miles of coastal marshes, pristine beaches and crystal waters in between comprise Gulf Islands National Seashore. The warm gulf waters, wide sandy beaches and historic mainland and island forts make for breathtaking surroundings and fascinating sightseeing.

Leisure activities include hiking, camping, fishing, sunbathing, boating, scuba diving and beachcombing. Boat ramps, bathhouses, shops, and fishing piers are among the facilities visitors may use to make their outing a more enjoyable experience.
