About 850,000 gallons of hot (143 degrees), bubbly water gushes from the base of Hot Springs Mountain each day in Hot Springs, Arkansas. Numerous bathhouses draw vacationers to this stylish city seeking the soothing, relaxing comforts of pure spring water.

The newly restored historic Fordyce Bathhouse which has been converted into the park's visitor center, features steam cabinets and tubs set in period decor. Visitors can bring containers to draw water from thermal-water fountains or cold-water springs to take home.

Hot Springs Mountain Tower rises 216 feet and offers stunning views of the city.
