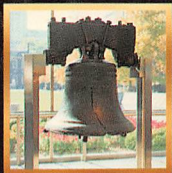

INDEPENDENCE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA

Philadelphia has long been recognized as a city steeped in American history. Independence National Historical Park encompasses 24 sites of interest, among them the world-renowned Liberty Bell. Historical structures from America's Colonial, Revolutionary and Federal eras, such as Independence Hall, Carpenter's Hall and Christ Church, are preserved and display period and original artifacts.

To preserve the integrity of the historical sites, the National Park Service has kept the narrow stairways and irregular pathways common to this era of history. Visitors are advised to walk carefully in these areas.

All the sites within the Historical Park are free and open to the public year-round, with longer operating hours in peak summer months.
