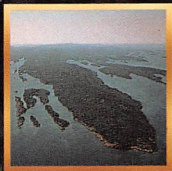

ISLE ROYALE NATIONAL PARK

Surrounded by the vast inland sea of Lake Superior, Isle Royale is a remote island wilderness, where the cry of the wolf and the song of the loon still reign supreme. The National Park belongs to Michigan, but is also bordered by Minnesota, and Ontario, Canada. The only ways to get to Isle Royale are by boat or seaplane, causing a visitor's experience to begin long before ever reaching the Park.

Isle Royale offers, wilderness, seclusion, solitude, recreation, and restoration—restoration of the human spirit. It is a wilderness to be entered on its own terms. It is a place of many meanings to many people. It is an adventure.
