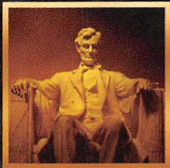

LINCOLN MEMORIAL

WASHINGTON, D. C.

The nation's tribute to the 16th President of the United States was created from 28 blocks of white Georgia marble. The widely recognized statue of a seated Abraham Lincoln, 19 feet tall and 19 feet wide, is within the memorial at West Potomac Park overlooking the National Mall.

Within the memorial's lower chambers is a pictorial/audio exhibit of Lincoln's life and heroic presidency during the turbulent Civil War. A bookstore is also on site.

Park Rangers lead interpretive talks daily, and answer visitor queries about the memorial.

SPECIAL INFORMATION
