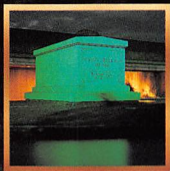

America's most profound and remembered civil rights leader was born and reared in this southern community revered as "Sweet Auburn."

Most of the 19 historical structures within Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historic Site have been restored as they originally appeared in 1930. Ranger-led tours of King's birth home are scheduled daily and other activities are planned throughout the year.

Other sites of historical importance and special events honoring King are Ebenezer Baptist Church, Martin Luther King, Jr. Center for Nonviolent Social Change, Inc., and the African-American Panoramic Experience (APEX).
