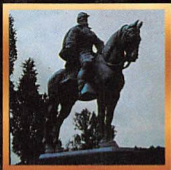

MANASSAS NATIONAL BATTLEFIELD PARK

VIRGINIA

The saga of the Civil War unfolds through the many exhibits, tours and audio-visual presentations at Manassas National Battlefield Park.

The Confederate Army won yet another decisive victory at Manassas in 1862. More than 3,000 soldiers were killed in only three days of battle. Fighting the previous year resulted in approximately 900 deaths and ended the notion that the war's outcome would be decided quickly.

First Manassas is a one-mile long walking tour of the 1861 battleground. Second Manassas is a 12-mile long self-guided driving tour of the 1862 battle site.
