MINUTE MAN



The American Revolution stemmed from a battle that erupted here between locals and British authorities. The ensuing battle claimed the lives of 73 British troops and 49 colonial military men.

The significance of this confrontation and the history that followed, namely the American Revolution, are featured in interpretive exhibits, film presentations, ranger programs, and living history re-enactments at Minute Man National Historical Park

Among the historical legends whose lives were tied to park sites are Paul Revere, Louisa May Alcott and Nathaniel Hawthome.
